

Birds of Prey

As if there weren't enough birds at camp before with all the Swallows, Swans, Ptenchiki, Turkeys and Kookaburras, now we had a raven show up for the party and an owl watching the campfire and then remaining on the branch, looking down at us trying to figure out why it was in the spotlight.

The owl was able to halt our progression from the campfire up to the parade ground by around 10 minutes. All it did was sit on a branch very high up and not make any sound.

Be aware that owls often eat small children up-to the age of 13, so all of Ptenchiki and Volchata as well as some

younger guides and scouts should take this into consideration and only travel in groups when going anywhere. Owls sweep down without a sound and their prey often stands no chance.

In folklore, owls are seen as wise and smart birds. Minevra and Athena are both associated with owls in Greek mythology. In Russian tales there is sometimes an old wise owl (Старый Филин) who sits and talks to heroes.

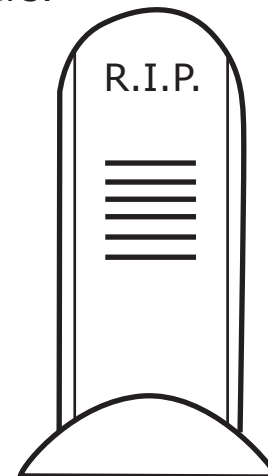

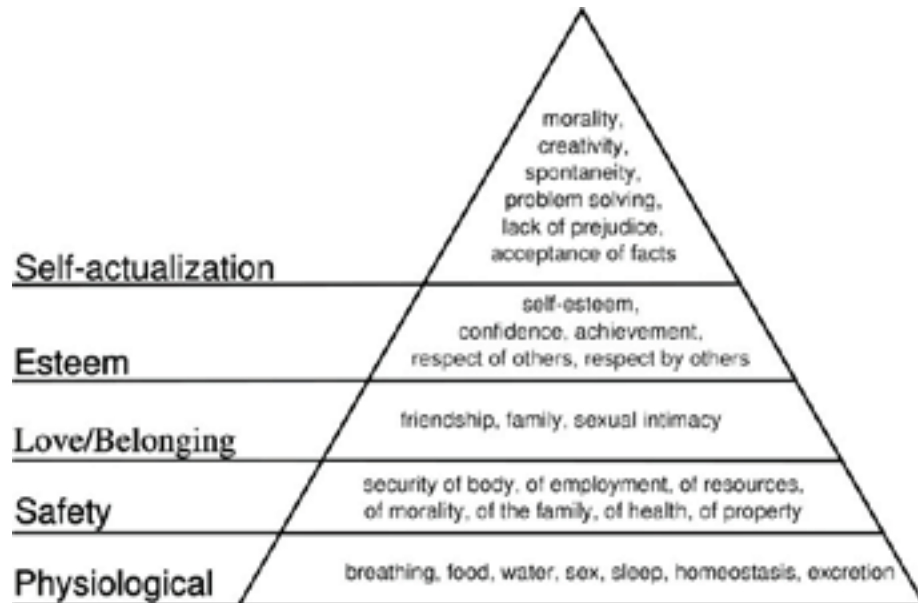
